Dear Pastor Wynn and Church,

I greet you in the name of our LORD and SAVIOUR JESUS CHRIST! I Peter 4:7 says, “But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer.” For more than seven months since March when our President announced the quarantine due to COVID-19 pandemic; almost everybody is worried-believers and unbelievers alike. The difference is, the believers are settled and confident of their final destiny; to GOD be the glory of this assurance of eternal life promised to us by our SAVIOUR; though we experienced and still experiencing difficulties brought by the pandemic we are rest assured and leaning on to HIS promise.

As an update of the work in Uganda, my worker didn't go out to soul-win from March-July due to the Covid-19. He resumed sharing the Gospel in August; by GOD'S grace, 26 people professed their faith on the LORD JESUS as their LORD and SAVIOUR from August-September. I resumed also teaching Bible stories to the children in our neighborhood by the sea side. I've been doing this before the pandemic when I've no schedules to deputize. I tried also



sharing the Gospel to adult people. There are seven adults who professed their faith on the LORD JESUS CHRIST; to GOD be the glory for this. There was a time in July, going back to Uganda, you will be quarantined for 14 days in a certain Hospital and pay \$100 per day for 14 days. This is a lot of money and I can't afford it. But now the Uganda Government has opened their Airport. The requirement for foreigners, must have a negative result from an accredited laboratory in the country of origin (Philippines) the Covid-19 polymerize chain reaction, but the problem is Qatar Airways has no flights yet to Uganda. The Qatar Airways offered rebooking of free charge until December 31, 2020. After this date if the pandemic is still so much active we will wait for further guidelines from Qatar Airways.

My faithful brethren, I thank you so much of your regular support through prayers and financial despite of the pandemic. May you please pray for me, 1. That the soonest possible I can go back to Uganda, 2. May GOD provide financially for a motorcycle for the ministries? Lira, Uganda is now a city on August 6 and won't allow bicycles anymore in the city. Bicycle is our (my worker and I) means of transportation in our visitation and soul winning to villages.
