We start the 3rd quarter by welcoming Bro. Kim John Lim, a Missionary - Intern from Grace Baptist Church – Tacloban City. It was a long wait for Bro. Kim, as it took him almost a year waiting for his missionary and residence visas, Covid Lockdown and stranded in Manila prior to his flight to Dar es Salaam, which he arrived safe and healthy last July 23, just in time to speak for the 3rd Anniversary of Bible Baptist Mission of Kariakoo. The Anniversary service was held in facility of the church in Kimara. Here where the Filipino Church was congregating since the outbreak of the Covid – 19. The Lord blessed the ‘ Calibrated ’ Anniversary service with about 40 people. The Filipino church is now back in her regular place of worship in Kariakoo. While the ministry was limited during the Pandemic, we took our efforts in construction works and site developments. In the Church in Kimara, we laid concrete paving blocks at the property parking and playground areas and also, in the Mission Church in Kibaha, electrical wiring were laid out and worked on the ceiling of their building, We thank the Lord for the provision of these projects.
