For almost three months now of staying here in Bulacan waiting for the announcements from Ethiopian Airlines that Argentina would soon be open and would receive international flights, we just rely on the grace of God. We continue our ministering to our people in Iglesia Bautista Consejero every Monday Morning for our Sunday Worship service and Thursday morning for our Wednesday evening Prayer Meeting by live streaming and video recording. We also have a Saturday morning Bible studies with our young people via Zoom.

God is so good because we had visited some of our supporting churches and had reported to them about the ministries in Argentina. I also had the privilege to share some encouraging thoughts to some pastors via Zoom. I had the opportunity also to share and report to some supporting pastors from BAMA the ministries we had in Argentina. We really are thankful to God for his love, faithfulness, guidance, protection and provisions for the last eight months for my three kids that we left in Argentina. This is the very first time and the very longest time that my wife and I were separated with our eldest, third and our youngest children. It is hard some and sometimes, I find myself crying because of longing for their presence, But God is faithful and His grace is sufficient to sustain us.

Our supposed flight that was canceled last Sept. 8 were now moved to a tentative dates such as last week of October or the first week of November, depending on the positive cases in Buenos Aires which is still rising. Please do pray for Argentina. Pray that God would heal the land. We really love and are anxious to go back to our mission field but because of this pandemic, we cannot return and cannot do anything. We'll just have to trust God and do the things that He wants us to do while we are still here in the Philippines.

We do thank you for your continues love and faithfulness in praying and supporting financially our family.
